APCE serves the educational ministries of the Reformed family of churches in association with the Presbyterian Church (USA), The Christian Educators of the Reformed Church in America (CERCA), the Presbyterian Church in Canada (PCC), the Christian Reformed Church (through CRC Publications Education Department), and the Moravian Association of Church Educators (MACE).

### Membership Levels

#### Professional Members

Volunteers who have responsibilities for church education and/or who support the concept of APCE.

#### Student Members

Persons who are enrolled as students in a college, university, or theological school working toward a degree in Christian Education or related field.
