

**MINISTER MEMBERS OF OTHER DENOMINATIONS NOT APPLYING
FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (USA)**

The Church Leadership Connection (CLC) system of the Presbyterian Church (USA) serves PC(USA) clergy, candidates, and ministers who are in the process of becoming PC(USA) clergy.

Ministers from Formula of Agreement Partner Denominations. If you are a minister of a Formula of Agreement partner denomination (Reformed Church in America, Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, or the United Church of Christ), you may serve as an installed or temporary pastor of PC(USA) congregations by invitation from a presbytery (regional governing body) of the PC(USA). You cannot circulate a Personal Information Form (PIF) through the CLC system. If you are interested in serving as a minister with a PC(USA) congregation or entity, you are encouraged to talk with your own judicatory of membership and then with that support, make yourself available to PC(USA) presbyteries in which you are able to serve. You should not contact a PC(USA) congregation to express your interest in serving. More information on Orderly Exchange can be found at www.pcusa/clc????

Ministers from Other Denominations. If you are not a PC(USA) minister, candidate, or minister in the process of becoming a PC(USA) minister, we regret to inform you that you cannot circulate a Personal Information Form through the CLC system. Ministers from other denominations may only serve PC(USA) congregations at the discretion of the presbytery (regional body) and in temporary positions. If you wish to be considered for such service, contact the Executive/General Presbyter of the presbytery where you are willing to serve.
