It must be notarized, and submitted to the stated clerk of the presbytery to be forwarded to the Office of the General Assembly at the time the presbytery reports the name of the elected delegate.

PERMISSION AUTHORIZATION/RELEASE OF LIABILITY

2004. I hereby give permission for this minor child to participate as a Youth Advisory Delegate for
_____ (presbytery) at the 216th General Assembly (2004) of the
Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) which will be held June 26 – July 3, 2004 in Richmond, VA. I hereby
acknowledge that the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and its related entities, officers, employees, and agents
do not assume any liability for loss or damage to this minor's personal property or for injury, sickness or
death arising out of the minor's participation as a Youth Advisory Delegate at the 216th General Assembly
(2003). I, my successors, and assigns, hereby waive any claims, demands or causes of action, against the
Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and its related entities, officers, employees, and agents for any loss or
damage to the minor's personal property or any injury, sickness or death, which may arise out of
participation as a Youth Advisory Delegate at the 216th General Assembly (2004), plus travel to, from,
and at the General Assembly.

Further, I understand that the activities in which the minor child will participate include, but are not limited
to the following: plenary meetings of the General Assembly; committee meetings; worship services;
caucus meetings of youth advisory delegates; and special events planned for the youth advisory delegates
such as dinners, parties, dances, tours and/or boat cruises. I understand that the Presbyterian Church
(U.S.A.) and its related entities, officers, employees and agents, do not provide chaperones for the youth
advisory delegates or other participants during these activities and that participation in the General
Assembly will also include free time which is not supervised.

AUTHORIZATION TO CONSENT TO MEDICAL AND DENTAL TREATMENT

Further, in order for the minor child to participate as a Youth Advisory Delegate at the 216th General Assembly (2004) of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) I hereby authorize the representative designated by the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and its related entities, officers, employees, and agents to consent to any x-ray examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis or treatment, and hospital care to be rendered to the minor child under the supervision and on the advice of any physician or surgeon licensed to practice in the state of occurrence, and to consent to any x-ray examination, anesthetic, dental or surgical diagnosis treatment, and hospital care to be rendered to the minor by any dentist licensed to practice in the state of occurrence. It is my intent that no medical treatment be delayed or withheld from the minor child due to my absence or unavailability. This grant of authority shall be effective from the minor's departure from home until return to home following the General Assembly.

I have read this document (consisting of Permission Authorization/Release of Liability and Authorization to Consent to Medical and Dental Treatment) and fully understand and accept such risks and therefore sign this document and all that it represents.
