Appoint Bhatti and Francis as Trustees on CEET

The Board of Directors **VOTED** to appoint Mr. Salim Bhatti and Mr. David Francis to serve as Presbyterian Church (USA) trustees on the Christian Education Endowment Trust (CEET) in Pakistan for term of four (4) years, ending at the close of the Annual Meeting in 2010.

Confirm Permission to Sell Portion of Saharanpur Property

The Board of Directors **VOTED** to

1. authorize the change from "Active Mission Use" to "Not Needed for Mission Use" of Presbyterian Church (USA) Property No. INSP001.
2. confirm the permission given by the General Assembly Council in February 2004 (See excerpt from minutes below.) to the COEMAR India Board to sell a portion of the land adjoining the Seminary Parsonage, Saharanpur Property No. INSP001. The legal description of the subject land is to be provided to the Executive Vice President/CFO prior to completion of the sale. The sales proceeds are to be divided according to the percentages spelled out in the Management Agreement with the Church of North India Trust Association (CNITA).

Excerpt from Minutes of the Board of Directors, PC(USA), a Corp dated February 14, 2004: “Approve, upon the recommendation of the WMD Committee, the following land transfers and sales for property located in India:

A. Sale of Land from Property No. INSP001, Saharanpur

The sale of approximately 2,000 square yards of land from Property No. INSP001. The sale proceeds, minus 10% for the Church of North India Trust Association (CNITA) administrative costs, will be used to purchase a piece of land for the construction of a new school to be operated by the Diocese of Agra, the location to be determined at a later date.”

Approve Transfer of Korean Property to Hannam University

The Board of Directors **VOTED** to give the Executive Vice President/ CFO and the Director of the Worldwide Ministries Division the joint authority to approve the transfer of the title to the real property currently used by the Taejon Christian International School (TCIS) in Taejon, Korea, to Hannam University, a mission partner of the Church, when all legal requirements for the transfer are met and under the following terms:

- 1) That Hannam University be responsible for all registration and legal expenses related to the transfer of the ownership, and
- 2) That Hannam University receive the property from TCIS in a timely manner and utilize the property for purposes consistent with the mission of the University, and
- 3) That Hannam University provide housing and salary support of Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) mission personnel assigned to work with the University, and
- 4) That Hannam University will support establishment of educational institutions in North Korea in partnership with the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) when an appropriate opportunity is presented.

As to terms 3) and 4), Hannam University and Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), A Corporation, through its juridical person in Korea, will enter into a written contract specifying the details of what Hannam University will do to meet these two terms in exchange for the title of the real property being transferred to Hannam University. The provisions of this written contract are subject to the approval of the Director of Worldwide Ministries Division and the Executive Vice-President/CFO of Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), A Corporation.

Once the PCUSA Office of Legal Service's has determined there is no legal barrier to the transfer and the Executive Vice President, CFO & Treasurer and the Director of Worldwide Ministries have approved it, the transfer will be completed.

ADJOURN

Following the above actions, the Board of Directors then **VOTED** to rise from the Board of Directors of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), A Corporation, and Its Constituent Corporations, and reconvene as the General Assembly Council.

There being no further business for consideration, the meeting of the Board of Directors of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), A Corporation and Its Constituent Corporations, was adjourned at 11:21 a.m. with prayer by Nancy Kahaian.
