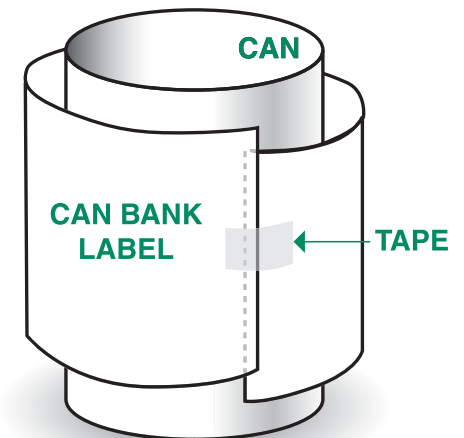

Bank label instructions for the Networkers Nickels for Nets Can Bank

Here's how you CAN make a bank to support the NetWorkers project:

1. Cut the label off this instruction sheet. In the blank area of the label, children may write their name or draw a picture. Or you may wish to write in basic instructions for your Nickels for Nets project.
2. Use any standard size can. (An empty soup can works well.) Make sure the top has been removed carefully, so there are no sharp edges.
3. Wrap the label around the can and glue or tape over the seam.
4. Cut a circular piece of nylon net, 6" in diameter. Cut a small slit (about 1-1/2") in the middle of the net.
5. Center the net over the open top of the can and let the extra fabric hang down around the upper edge of the can. Tie a string or ribbon on top of the overhanging net, around the upper edge of the can, to hold the net top in place. (Putting a rubberband around the fabric, under the ribbon, will hold it more securely.)
