Presbyterian Men

Rules for the Church Man of the Year Award

- 1. Any man in the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) is eligible for this Award.**
- 2. He must have the endorsement of the Session of the church in which he is a member, or of the Presbytery Council of the Presbytery he is a member of, if the nomination is for a Presbyterian Man of the Year.**
- 3. The Session or Presbytery is requested to endorse only one man in any given year.**
- 4. The reason(s) for nomination for the Award shall be noted on the Nominating Form for Church Man of the Year.**
- 5. The reason(s) will ordinarily include outstanding service to the Church and/or Community.**
- 6. The Nomination Form should be in the hands of the Executive Board of the National Council of Presbyterian Men no later than one month from the time the Award is to be presented.**
- 7. It is NOT necessary for the Church submitting the Nomination Form to have a chartered Presbyterian Men's organization.**
- 8. If a man nominated is so-elected by the Executive Board of the NCPM,Inc., he will be recognised at next annual meeting of the NCPM,Inc.**
- 9. If the nominee cannot appear in person, arrangements should be made by the nominating session to appoint someone to receive the award as proxy.**
- 10. The recipient should be further recognised (1) by a presentation in the church of which he is a member by the Pastor, or (2) at a subsequent Presbytery meeting by the Presbytery Representative to Presbyterian Men.**
- 11. A copy of this form is kept at by the current President of the National Council of Presbyterian Men, Inc. and all previous records are in his file.**
- 12. The purpose of the Award is to encourage others, by their example to stir up the gift of God within them and to bring such a vitality of inspiration and motivation for the Gospel that many will become active followers of Christ**
