The RECONCILE Training Centre in South Sudan is situated on a beautiful, quiet compound just outside of the city of Yei. A library, training hall, and dormitory with indoor facilities are provided for the students' accommodation and training. The centre offers recreational opportunities such as volleyball, board games, and videos as well as daily chapel. The centre is within easy walking distance of the town and several places of worship.



About RECONCILE

RECONCILE is a church-related, indigenous ecumenical institution established in 2003 by the New Sudan Council of Churches to promote civic education and trauma healing in an endeavor to mitigate conflicts between communities in Sudan. It has trained many church and community leaders throughout the country.

The people of Sudan have experienced 21 years of civil war; the time has finally come to turn the swords into plowshares! While there is great hope amongst the people of Sudan, there is also the sober realization that it is a tough road ahead in order for Sudanese society to make the transformation into a society that embraces peace. The situation requires a cadre of Sudanese leaders who are trained in trauma healing, peace studies, and conflict transformation to be raised up. This is a primary mission of RECONCILE. To that end we have developed three-month residential courses in Community Based Trauma Healing and Peace Studies/Conflict Transformation in cooperation with and accredited by Mindolo Ecumenical Foundation of Zambia.

Community Based Trauma Healing

This course looks at trauma from five perspectives: recognition, responding, recovery, reintegration, and reconciliation. It consists of six two-week modules:

1. Recognizing Trauma
2. Journey of Trauma
3. Responding to Trauma in Healthy and Helpful Ways
4. Trauma Healing for Special Populations
5. People for People Peace Building
6. Community Mobilization and Leadership for Peace

Peace Studies and Conflict Transformation

This course provides knowledge and skills in handling conflict and promoting peace. It consists of six two-week modules:

1. Conflict Analysis
2. Community Based Trauma Healing
3. Non-Violence: Faith-Based, Philosophy and Practice
4. Leadership, Good Governance and Peace building
5. People for People Peace Building
6. Community Education and Mobilization for Peace



Students are provided with materials developed for the Sudanese context.

Instruction

Instruction will be provided by professional adjunct faculty who are experts in their fields. Some courses will be co-taught by such instructors and RECONCILE program staff.
