INTERNATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSES

AFRICA

Democratic Republic of Congo \$95,000

- Micro-Devu project – a food security project in partnership with Foods Resource Bank (FRB)
- Moringa project - continuation of program work with the Presbyterian Church of Kinshasa Health Department's nutrition program for malnourished children, specifically AIDS orphans, by promoting the planting and use of Moringa trees.
