WHAT IS BEING DONE.

One Great Hour of Sharing and designated funds from Presbyterian Disaster Assistance are now at work on your behalf throughout the Midwest. \$90,000 has been sent to eight different presbyteries affected by the flooding. Six members of the PDA National Response Team have been deployed to serve as resources, provide assistance in relief and recovery efforts, and to represent the care and concern of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)
