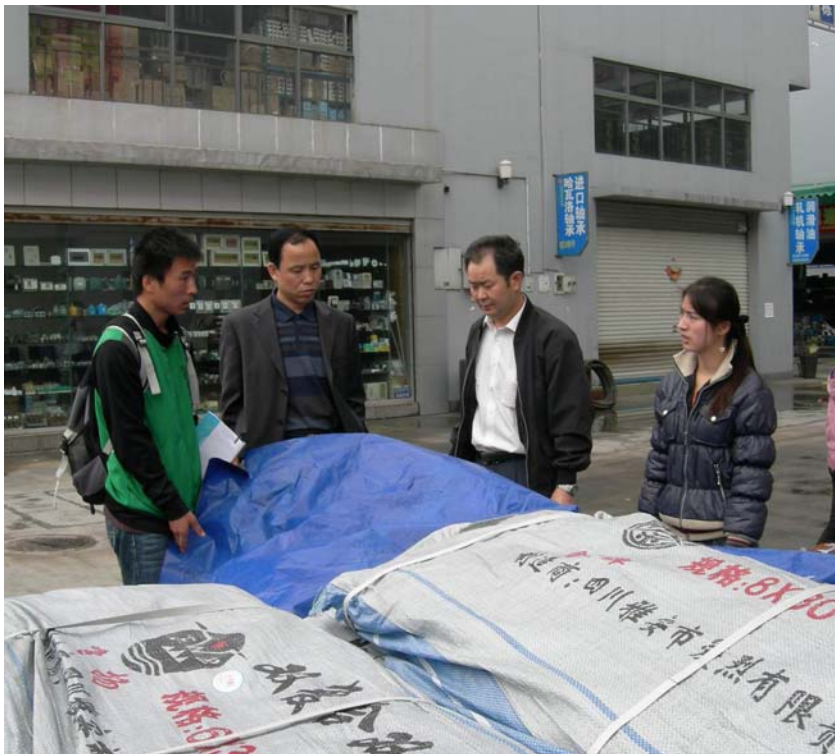

The shocks and tremors of the devastating earthquake in southwest China affected more than 20 provinces and killed at least 34,000 people. An additional 30,000 are missing, and many are in relief camps without proper shelter, food or clean water.

With your help, Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, as the relief ministry of PC(USA), is working to help survivors find hope and a return to normalcy in a time when everything is still being shaken.



WHAT IS BEING DONE

PDA is providing ongoing support to the Amity Foundation, our local and long-term mission partner in China. Amity, a fellow member of Action by Churches Together (ACT) International, is taking the lead in the ACT response. \$50,000 from One Great Hour of Sharing funds has been sent to help with the distribution of 240,000 kilos of rice to 16,000 people and plastic sheeting and quilts to provide shelter and warmth to 8,000 families impacted by the disaster.

Following the initial crisis phase, Amity will assist in rebuilding communities, including 600 homes, 10 schools and 5 clinics. Other rehabilitation assistance will target destroyed or severely damaged water and irrigation systems.
