Flooding in Tabasco, Mexico, has affected 1,300,000 people, caused major damage to water and sanitation infrastructure, crops and livestock.

\$30,000 has already been sent to support six different Presbyteries sheltering thousands of displaced people, and the Presbyterian Church of Mexico may cancel its General Assembly to divert the savings to humanitarian response in Tabasco. PDA disaster specialists in Central America stand ready to assist, yet nothing can happen until the waters recede.
