Travel Tips and Information

Nashville International Airport (BNA)

Major airlines fly into Nashville. Find information at <http://www.flynashville.com/>. Baggage Claim is on Level 2 and Ground Transportation on Level 1.

Driving from the airport to the hotels:

From Nashville International Airport, turn I-40 to 209A Broadway. Turn right on Broadway to 7th Avenue. Turn left on 7th Avenue. Go one block to Commerce St. Hotel is at 611 Commerce St., on the corner of 7th Avenue and Commerce.

Ground Transportation from Nashville International Airport

Taxi service is a flat \$25.00 USD (one way) with \$1.00 for each additional passenger for up to four passengers.

Car rental: There are eight car rental companies with counter space on Level 1 of the airport.

Airport shuttle service: Gray Line, www.graylinenashville.com, offers a discounted APCE fee of \$16.00 round-trip from the airport to the hotel from 5:00 am to 11:00 pm daily. The shuttle leaves the airport every 15 minutes and the hotel every 30 minutes. The Gray Line kiosk is

located on Level 1. Remember to mention APCE for the discounted rate! **The hotel does not provide shuttle service.**

Hotel Parking: On- or off-site self-parking is \$6.00 USD daily. Valet parking: \$25.00 a day.

Driving to Nashville:

Train Service:

There is no Amtrak service to Nashville.
