



Tip Sheet for *Faith for Life*₂

Overview: (developed by a Presbyterian pastor for Presbyterian congregations)

*Faith for Life*₂ (FFL2) from the Logos Ministry™ is designed for holistic mid-week, Sunday evening, or summer education* for children, middle, and high school youth. In this church-wide program adults participate in significant ways with children and youth, upholding the promise of baptismal vows to “build young disciples.” A meal, games, study, and worship are a part of the overall program.

The purpose of this curriculum is to build relationships and experiences of faith in study with the entire church community: the vocabulary, rituals, liturgy, hymns, scripture, and stories. 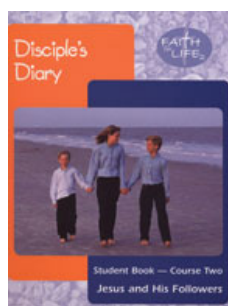


*If chosen for Sunday morning, FFL2 fits congregations that have individual grade level classes for children and middle school.

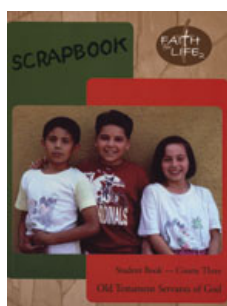

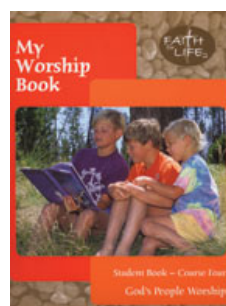
Course 1 (1st)

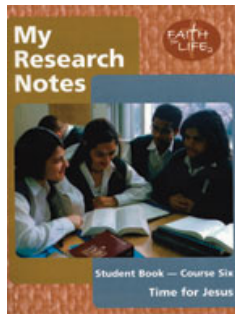

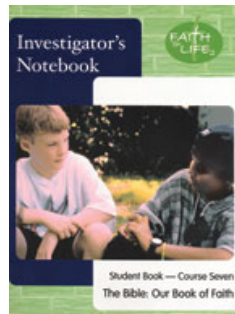

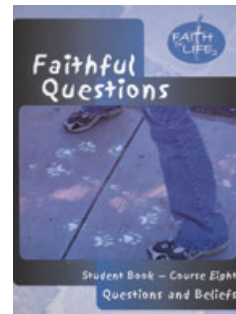
Three Courses for Middle School: (See page 24, Summer 2008 *ideas!*)

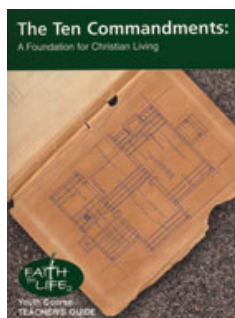
Course 8 (8th)*

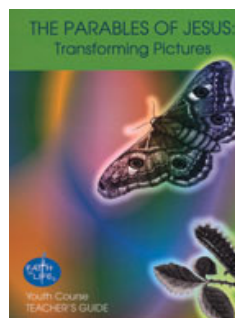

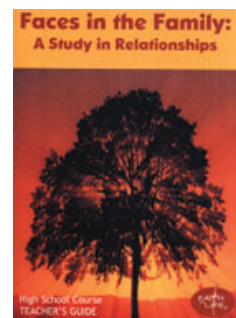

These three courses are for high school students in grades 9 through 12. They offer topical short-term studies (10 sessions) of 45 to 60 minutes. A congregation would order one Teacher's Guide per teacher (\$15.99). The Student Journal is a free online blog with instructions in the Teacher's Guide about how to join.
