2009 Kuyuk Bible Study

The office of Korean Adult Resource Development in Congregational Ministries Publishing has published the Kuyuk Bible study for over ten years. The Kuyuk Bible study, written by Korean Presbyterian pastors, has twelve sessions to be used as monthly small-group Bible studies and intercessory prayer meetings. It reflects the life and faith of Korean American immigrants and congregations and connects with a variety of subjects such as discipleship, caring ministry, stewardship, justice, and peacemaking issues.

The 2009 Kuyuk Bible study reflects on the Beatitudes and the Lord's Prayer. Many Christians are struggling in pursuit of true happiness and blessings in their everyday lives in a culture in which people are obsessed by materialistic values. True blessings come from loving God and our neighbors. Jesus gives us a radically different understanding and definition of blessings in the Beatitudes and the Lord's Prayer. We need to renew our hearts and minds by practicing what Jesus teaches us.
