Pledge Card Instructions PW Mission Pledge

The pledge cards are designed to be used by Presbyterian Women in the Congregation (PWC) circles.

In 2009, the **treasurer of each circle** (or the circle member responsible for pledges) should

- prepare an envelope for each woman in the circle. Write the woman's name on the outside of the envelope and insert a pledge card.
- distribute the envelopes to the circle members, asking them to write their pledges and return them to the circle treasurer at the same meeting.
- add the pledges of all circle members and report this amount to the treasurer of the PWC.

In 2010, the **treasurer of each circle** (or the circle member responsible for pledges) should

- redistribute the envelopes at each circle meeting, asking the circle members to donate their money and note the amount given.
- send the money collected at each meeting to the treasurer of the PWC.
- at the end of the year, sign the pledge cards and return them to the circle members so they may use them as receipts for tax purposes.

In 2009, the **treasurer of each PWC** (or the PWC member responsible for pledges) should

- fill out the Mission Pledge Form for PW in the Congregation and send it to the Presbyterian Women in the Presbytery (PWP) moderator or Celebration Giving representative by November 15, 2009.

In 2010, the **treasurer of each PWC** (or the PWC member responsible for pledges) should

- send quarterly installments of the pledges from your congregation to the PWP treasurer by March 10, June 10, September 10 and December 10, 2010.
