**Strengthening the PC(USA)**

Which Offering is received in the spring, comes from the heritage of our Southern churches and was started in 1922 with a challenge to give one penny for each year of life as “a gift to the girls school in Japan”? Today up to 5 projects are funded with this money annually.

**Birthday Offering**

Which prayer movement links prayer and coins of many countries, symbolizing prayer for peace and reconciliation? It was begun in 1956 by Shanti Solomon of India, who believed that women anywhere could have a sense of being part of a worldwide family of faith as they prayed for peace and reconciliation in the family, the community, the nation and the world.

**The Fellowship of the Least Coin**

Which endowment fund was established to celebrate the 10th anniversary of PW? Money will be used for financial resources for critical and innovative ministries above and beyond the current funding pattern of the church.

**Widening the Circle Fund**

Which Offering started in 1888 and designates 40 percent of funds to support hospitals and health ministries throughout the world?

**Thank Offering**

What is the name of pledge that funds the basic operating budgets of PW at all levels? It is sometimes considered “second-mile giving” as it is above what women have already given to their local church budgets. From this money, more than \$2 million is given to the mission budget of the PC(USA).

**PW Mission Pledge**

Who receives and disburses PW funds, keeps accurate financial records, and reports regularly to the coordinating team?

**The PW Treasurer**

Who keeps accurate records of coordinating team meetings and Gatherings, is the correspondent for PW and sends in name changes after elections?

**The PW Secretary**

Who is familiar with the responsibilities of the Moderator, serving in her absence or on request? She may also have specific duties stated in your by-laws, such as justice & peace or missions coordinator.

**The Vice-Moderator**

Who maintains and preserves the historical records of PW, maintains files of information, brochures, photos, etc. and writes the annual historical report of your PW?

**The PW Historian**

This PW leader has many new names. She helps congregations work more effectively, works with the Presbytery CT, shares her knowledge and talents and resources with PW. What is her title?

**The PW Cluster Leader, PW Energizer, PW Resource Coordinator (formerly PW Enabler)**

Every three years, a group travels to a designated area to study the needs and concerns of their women and children. They return and itinerate in their synods, telling the stories of the trip, so we can all learn. What is this trip called?

**The Global Exchange**

What event is held every three years to conduct the business of PW in the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)? Several thousand women gather for fellowship, plenaries, workshop, and the Business Meeting.

**The Churchwide Gathering**

This is an important part of who we are as PW. We speak out in various ways on issues that affect women and children, all over the world. This could include homelessness, fair wage, domestic violence, racism or a variety of other issues. What is this called?

**Advocacy**

From our conception, we were leaders in supporting foreign workers, projects that help the underserved all over the world, using our “egg money” to help others. We continue to support this through our Celebration Giving in many ways. What is this called?

**Mission**

Because of this training, many women have gone from PW members, to circle leaders to members of presbytery, synod and GA committees. PW continues to offer funds and training for women to enhance their skills and knowledge of the church and the world. What is this called?

**Leadership**

Before the Horizons Bible study is published, PW groups review the study during what process? Your church, circle, or coordinating team can participate in this experience.

**Field testing**

This is the most popular meat served at PW events.

**National Network of Presbyterian College Women**

This resource is new and gives us information on the hands-on mission opportunities, such as sewing. What is it called?

**Together in Service Guide**

This resource contains information on job descriptions, our relationship to the Presbyterian Church, PW structure, Celebration Giving, ideas and helps. What is it called?
