The 216th General Assembly (2004) adopted anti-racism recommendations:

- Encouraging middle governing bodies (including presbyteries and related entities) and local congregations to address issues of systemic racism
- Encouraging conferences that include workshops and worship services on reparations, reconciliation and renewal

To carry out the General Assembly's recommendations, the Anti-Racism Team is presenting speakers, panelists, and workshop leaders on:

- Historical, economic, and related social justice aspects of reparations
- Biblical and theological dimensions of reparations and reconciliation
- Concrete ideas for preaching and teaching the issues in the local church (including prepared materials that can be used in local churches)
