This includes information from the Black Congregational Enhancement Office, the Native American Congregational Enhancement Office, and the Asian Congregational Enhancement Office, all offices within the Racial Ethnic Ministries Program Area, National Ministries Division, and previous years' reports. We also worked with presbytery offices to resolve discrepancies for a number of churches that did report. As a result, the table reflects information for 99.5% of congregations.
