I first met Rana while visiting the small, tribal village of Koriakandi, Bangladesh," writes mission co-worker Dr. Cynthia Morgan. A handsome boy about seven years of age, Rana looked at me curiously, yet serenely. He was a child used to waiting—to not getting his own way. Rana had been deaf since birth."

After checking his ears carefully and finding nothing wrong, Dr. Morgan arranged for Rana to be evaluated by an audiologist in the town of Rajshahi, where PC(USA)-supported Christian Mission Hospital is located. The test confirmed that his hearing loss was profound and that a hearing aid would be of no benefit.
