

**Do you want to study theology abroad for a year and get to know the situation in Latin America first hand?
Then the University Institute – ISEDET in Buenos Aires is exactly what you are looking for!**



The University Institute ISEDET in the Argentine capital is a privately run University, recognized by the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Argentina. Nine Churches, all of whose origins lie in the Reformation and the Pre-reformation, who were formed after 1825 by immigration and mission in the Southern Cone of Latin America, sustain ISEDET. ISEDET is the result of the fusion, in 1969, of the Evangelical School of Theology (whose predecessor was founded in 1884) and the Lutheran School of Theology (founded in 1955).

ISEDET offers you:

- The possibility of taking classes and seminars of your own choice. Many classes have an emphasis on the theology and the situation of Latin America.
- Participation in the Forum on Theology and Gender.
- An international community with students from all of Latin America.
- An ecumenical faculty.
- The Carnahan Lectures in October of each year, with a theologian of international renown.
- The theological library with the most varied collection in Latin America with works in Spanish, Portuguese, English, German, Italian and French.
- Official certificates and records of study.
- The possibility to live in individual rooms, rooms for two people or in small apartments.
- The possibility for intense contacts, internships in the communities and social outreach programs of the nine Churches associated with ISEDET.
- The fascinating city of Buenos Aires!

The first semester of the academic year begins in March and concludes in the beginning of July; the second semester begins in August and terminates in mid-December. Even though it is possible to study at ISEDET for only one semester, it is always recommended to spend a whole year (from March to December or from August to July of the following year).

Tuition to study for one semester is US \$850.-, regardless of the quantity of classes, seminars, credits and other programs that are taken advantage of.
