PROVIDE CLEAN WATER

Water is life — projects and tools that help provide clean water to families and entire communities

Deep Rock Well ITEM OG30016 **\$15,000**

A deep rock well taps into pure water sources hundreds of feet below ground, providing access to clean water even during drought and other extreme weather conditions. These sustainable wells serve entire communities in the most water-scarce regions of the world and are placed in areas where they can make the greatest impact and be maintained by trained community members.

Rainwater Catchment System ITEM OG10009 \$75

These systems harvest rainwater for use in gardens, cooking and everyday tasks. The collection, storage and filtering of rainwater can supply a reliable source of water during devastating dry seasons.

Water Filter ITEM OG30012 \$50

In many places around the world, families must cope with contaminated water systems that put their health at risk. Your gift of a water filter provides a reliable source of safe water for drinking, bathing and cooking — supporting better health and hygiene for households both locally and globally.

A Mountain of Change

High in the Nepalese mountains sits Gorkha, a village as vulnerable as the Nepalese people themselves, comprising of just 75 households. Historically, the residents of Gorkha had to trek 45 minutes downhill to get clean water for their families, then haul it back up the mountain. In 2015, Gorkha was at the epicenter of a catastrophic earthquake which destroyed their nearest water source. Working in collaboration with the PC(USA), Juneli Nepal, a trusted partner, was able to provide a safe, clean source of drinking water for the village.

Garden Well ITEM OG10029 \$50/share | \$1,500/well

A well and hand pump provide a reliable and convenient source of clean water for drinking, bathing, washing and irrigation. Access to clean water close to home can transform daily life — improving health, hygiene and opportunity. Garden wells are major investments for individuals and families. Give the gift of an entire well, or give a share to combine your support with others and make a lasting impact.

Mzuzu Drill ITEM OG10039 \$115

This equipment provides communities with simple and cost-effective technology to access water. This hand-operated drilling method can reach depths of fifteen to twenty meters, creating a sustainable water source. The drills are constructed by local laborers and maintained using locally sourced materials.

With dependable water access, farmers can improve their crop yields, allowing them to feed their families and increase their income. Providing the tools to make water accessible allows our partners to work closely with farmers to restore their capacities and enable harvests in areas where civil unrest and drought may have created food insecurity.

Cut from a Different Cloth

Like many young mothers in her region of South Sudan, Nyalong faced a lifetime of manual labor to support her four children. “Every day was a struggle for survival,” she said, recalling the constant fear and exhaustion that characterized that period in her life.

But for Nyalong, it was never a question of whether she would take care of her children, only how she would do so. That’s why she joined a vocational training program in her community — led by Hope Restoration South Sudan and supported by the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) — where she learned to sew and tailor clothes, among other things.

The sewing machine she received in part because of gifts made through the Giving Catalog became the compass for her new path forward. With this simple tool, Nyalong discovered she could stitch together a better future for her family.

Safeguarding Homes After Disasters

Since Hurricane Maria hit Puerto Rico in 2017, our partner, Techos Pa' Mi Gente (TPMG; Roofs for My People) has worked tirelessly to rebuild roofs for 130 families on the island.

Families like the single mother living with two children in a bat-infested home that was crumbling around them. The bat guano had made it hazardous for the family to even breathe the air inside their home.

TPMG was able to replace the roof on their house, and collaborate with a local company to have the bats safely relocated and to remove the guano.

In the wake of federal funding rollbacks, the partnerships you make possible through the PC(USA) are more important than ever.

Many Hands Make Light Work

When it comes to activating a network, few organizations are more effective than our trusted partner, Praja Abhilasha.

Because Praja Abhilasha understands that strong land tenure rights contribute to the resilience of farming and fisher communities, they — with support from the PC(USA) — engaged 2,451 women in organized land rights campaigns and were successful in reclaiming 254 acres of land — acres that are necessary to provide food sovereignty and economic security for hundreds of families.

Not only did they succeed in having land returned, they also made it possible for women to have a voice in policy shaping.
